NAB CRYSTAL RADIO AWARD PRESENTED TO KKLI-FM

WASHINGTON, DC -- KKLI-FM Colorado Springs, Colo. today was awarded the National Association of Broadcasters Crystal Radio Award. Since 1987, the NAB Crystal Radio Awards have recognized radio stations for their outstanding year-round commitment to community service.

Ten winners were chosen from among <u>50 finalists</u>. Recipients were recognized at today's NAB Show Radio Luncheon.

KKLI-FM provided this description of its accomplishments in 2008:

Colorado Springs is home to Pikes Peak, the Air Force Academy, NORAD, the Olympic Training Center, a hall of fame pitcher, a race car legend and one radio station that beats at the heart of this community, KKLI 106.3. During KKLI's 23-year history, people have been entertained by its music and inspired by its call to action. Again in 2008, KKLI was involved in the city it calls home. KKLI has brought to light the tragedy of suicide, the sometimes violent readjustment for returning soldiers and the present danger of wild land fire. KKLI has been a beacon of information as area services shrink in light of budget shortfalls. KKLI has helped feed the hungry and clothe the poor during times of high gas prices and massive layoffs. KKLI has offered a platform for local organizations to get their message out and help them raise funds to continue their work. KKLI's small but engaged staff of three announcers, a promotions director and one intern has been instrumental in raising the city's awareness and more than \$1.2 million for local organizations in 2008.
